MAP testing: From Tuesday, October 20 to Friday, October 30.

Starting today, Monday October 19, 2009, Mrs. Debbie Bayless will be testing the reading level of all our students from 2nd to 8th grade. Kindergarten has its inventory testing system and 1st grade will be done by its own teacher. Again the attendance and focus of your child(ren) to school these days are very critical for us to be able to test your child and continue finding better intervention ways to help their individual needs.
